Increase in vehicle movements in and out of Cranleigh Sewage Works

Dear resident

We are writing to inform you of that, due to upgrade work at Cranleigh sewage treatment works, there will be a temporary increase in the number of heavy goods vehicles visiting the site to deliver construction materials.

We regret any impact that this may have and we will do all that we can to avoid inconveniencing you. The upgrade work is needed to increase the treatment capacity of the site, so we can continue to maintain our high sewage treatment standards.

How will this affect you?

The work will take place in 2 phases:

1. Building new filter tanks - during this phase, concrete lorries will make 30 trips per day for 2 days at a time.
2. Filling the new filters with media - during this phase, tipper lorries will make 12 trips per day for 5 days at a time, on 2 occasions.

You may notice the increase in heavy goods traffic along Elmbridge Road and entering and leaving the treatment works. The vehicles will be visiting during normal working hours and there will be no increase in noise in the early mornings or in the evenings.

When will it take place?

You may notice an increase in lorry traffic during four periods, as follows:

- For a 2-day period from 7th to 8th November
- For a 5-day period from 21st to 25th November
- For a 5-day period from 5th to 9th December

We will do our best to adhere to these dates however, the dates may have to be altered slightly and if they do look likely to change, we will update you.
